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Section 6 - The Model Industry

1. Dealer, distributor, retailer of Control Line Precision Aerobatics equipment. Equipment defined as kits, partial or short kits, engines, engine parts, mufflers, fuel systems, fuel tanks, wings, control systems, landing gear, propellers, spinners, flying control lines, handles, building hardware and small parts, model airplane plans, instructional videos, event videos, etc. A viable "Catalog" of wares and/or examples of advertisements in magazines is required for verification.
2. Manufacturer – refers specifically to a person who designs, fabricates, tests, and then sells to the public equipment for control line precision aerobatics. A viable "catalog" of products and/or copies of advertisement for products in a magazine or website is required for verification.
3. Inventor/Researcher – documented research and development for control line precision aerobatics that results in a product offered for sale and use. Research in the form of statistics or theory must have been published in a magazine and reprints of articles must be furnished to the Hall of Fame Committee.

Be very specific and document all statements including dates. Include photocopies of brochures and catalogs of kits, equipment and supplies. Include photocopies of advertisement of manufactured goods that have appeared in magazines. General statements not documented will not be accepted.

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Section 7 - Recognition in the Hobby

To include the Academy of Model Aeronautics Aviation Hall of Fame membership, FAI Honors, Hobby Industry Honors, or similar honors.

The nomination will not be accepted unless a photograph(s) accompanies this Nomination Packet as listed below: Number of photographs submitted can be from one to five.

NO EXCEPTIONS

Type and quality of photograph

1. Period or Contemporary
 1. Period – during the active time of participation, i.e. 1958, 1965, etc.
 2. Contemporary - a recent picture with or without an airplane.
 3. Antique and/or damaged photographs (grainy, faded) are acceptable if no other is available. If needed, the Hall of Fame Committee will Photoshop the print.

2. Composition of the photograph
 1. **NO HAT OR SUNGLASSES.**
 2. Do not have a cluttered background (trees, cars, other persons, etc.)
 3. Nominee posing with an airplane – standing, kneeling, sitting.
 4. Nominee posing with an airplane and spouse.
 5. Nominee, airplane, and a trophy.
 - a. Walker Trophy or First place trophies from Junio, Senior and Advanced, Old Time, Classic stunt Divisions from the Nationals
 - b. First place trophy from Ignition, Old Time Classic from the Vintage Stunt Championships or one of the “special Awards” from the VSC.
 6. “Mug shot” is acceptable (head and shoulders) – **no hat or sunglasses.**

1. Hard copy – preferably 5 x 7 or 8 x 10. A 4 x 6 is acceptable. Picture will be returned if desired.
